Dues for the	Dues are pro-rated at \$5.50 per month from the month of joining the Club.
Year:	
Meetings:	Regular meetings are held on the 3 rd Sunday of every month, except for June, when it is held on the
	4th Sunday. All meetings start at 7 P.M., except for the December meeting, which starts at 6 P.M. in
	order to hold elections for officers and committee members.
Work Hours:	12 work hours are required per year, with at least 6 hours being completed between January 1st and
	June 30th. Work hours are valued at \$15.00 per hour and any un-worked hours will be billed on a
	semi-annual basis.
Fundraising	Members are encouraged to attend fundraising events, such as dinners, but are not required to do
Events:	so. Tickets to dinners are sold in advance, and members may bring guests.
Gate Lock and	The gate is kept locked unless a member is present. Upon arrival and unlocking of the gate and/or
Sign-In Sheet:	clubhouse lock(s), <i>you are required to zero the lock</i> (turn all numbers to zero). Located near the
	gate is a sign-in sheet. Please be sure to sign-in with your name and member number, list your
	reason for using the Club (range, pond, etc.) and be sure to sign-out as well.
Gun Range:	Range Rules are posted at the Gun Range. It is your responsibility to read and understand all
	<i>Range Rules</i> . The maximum distance for the range is 100 yards. Club events have priority usage.
	Otherwise, the range is available on a first-come, first-served basis. If a member is already shooting
	when you arrive, he/she has established the shooting distance. You may either join him/her at that
	distance or wait until that member is done. You are not allowed to shoot metal, glass, spinning, or
	exploding targets. When shooting at the backboard, do not shoot the wooden frame. Remember to
	remove your used targets and pick up your spent brass. Collection buckets for spent brass are
	located on the range and are marked as such.
Archery Range:	The Archery Range is separate from the Gun Range. 3-D targets are available, as well as a movable
	target.
Fishing Pond:	The fishing pond is "catch-and-release" for bass only. All other fish may be kept.
Clubhouse:	The combination to the Club House is the same as the gate lock. The clubhouse may be used by Club
-	members any time they are at the Club. Members may reserve the clubhouse for private parties by
	requesting such use, in advance, at a regular meeting. There is a \$50 fee for use of the Club for
	private parties, with the fee due at the time of the request. The Range will remain open until 4 P.M.,
	after which it can be requested to be closed by the renter of the clubhouse. The renter may have use
	of the kitchen upon request. Otherwise, the kitchen will be kept locked. Members who rent the
	clubhouse are responsible for all cleanup, and locking and zeroing all locks when finished.
Events:	Many shooting events are available throughout the year. A list of Coming Events is included with
	each month's meeting minutes. Children's events include an annual Fishing Derby, a .22 Rifle Youth
	Shoot, and a Youth Archery shoot. Other events will be announced as they become scheduled.
